## The Topics, in short:

### QUALIFYING TO COMPETE:

In today's market one has to qualify to compete. The EN 16763 Services Standard was the first stepping stone. National players must now begin to outline training programs that will support the continuous development of skills, experience and knowledge as well as establish qualification schemes that are accepted 'across Europe'.

### KEEPING SECURITY SECURE:

Information and Communication Technology (ICT) has opened new integration possibilities. But the ever-evolving risks for fire safety and security systems demand that new measures are defined and implemented to protect these against cyber-attacks, data theft and other threats.

### REGULATING CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS:

The Construction Products Regulation (CPR) lays down harmonised rules for the marketing of construction products in the EU. The implementation has however hindered the publication of harmonised EN's from the CEN Technical Committees 72 and 191 resulting in a complicated blockade.
